The event is part of the Vinarium Festival, which focuses on the display, preservation and promotion of the tangible and intangible cultural heritage of the local multilingual area. For several years now, the traditional “Lendava grape harvest” parade has been raising awareness among the local population and visitors about the importance and value of cultural heritage and enriching the cultural and tourist offer of the town and the region.

At a joint conference, all project partners presented their cultural heritage and the ways in which it is preserved, displayed and promoted. The “Lendava grape harvest” parade itself was an example of how cultural heritage becomes an important event for the identity and promotion of a place and its characteristics.

Through mutual discussions and presentations, we expect to prepare and implement joint projects that will contribute to the development and preservation of the cultural heritage of our cities.

Results and impacts

Event No.9: The event ended successfully with new insights, experiences and, above all, contacts with people who have experience in preparing and implementing projects. Together with our partners, we are developing European values and, in the future, joint projects for the preservation and development of cultural heritage, tourism, quality and sustainable living.

Dissemination

The large audience of the Harvest Festival got to know the participating towns. The programme received a lot of media coverage. Informing citizens about the close of the joint project. Presentation of foreign partners. Description of goals and tasks. The participating cities presented their experiences of the project in a presentation. Participants noted that the objectives set for the project had been jointly achieved. In total, 10 events were organised in the 6 participating countries.
